


NCF-Envirothon Mission



NATIONAL CONSERVATION FOUNDATION (NCF) ENVIROTHON— OHIO TO HOST



Students are challenged to develop critical thinking skills to create inventive solutions to the complex local and global environmental and natural resource issues facing our world today.

This international program is hosted by a different participating U.S. state or Canadian province each year. The 2022 NCF-Envirothon will bring together the top performing schools from these states, provinces and regions to compete for the Championship title right here in **OHIO**. Hundreds of students, teachers and volunteers from across the United States, Canada, and China will travel to Ohio to participate in this event for the opportunity to compete for recognition, scholarships and prizes.

The 2022 NCF-Envirothon competition will be held at Miami University, Oxford, Ohio from July 24 to July 29 and is being hosted by the Ohio Federation of Soil and Water Conservation Districts (OFSWCD) and the Ohio Envirothon State Committee (OEC).

The **OFSWCD** supports the work of Ohio's 88 Soil and Water Conservation Districts who for 75 year has been providing locally-driven solutions to natural resources concerns on both the rural and urban settings of the SWCD's various capacities.

The **OFSWCD** is the official sponsor of the Ohio Envirothon and together with the OEC has brought together educators

from around the state and has selected **Waste to Resources** as this year's theme. This current environmental issue



recognizes the urban-rural interface of our diverse state.
