- The awards celebration dress code is 'business casual' (i.e. pants/shirt, dress, suit, shoes) - NO t-shirts or shorts!

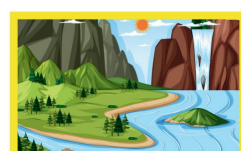
